The Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) is collecting the information in this form to assist the Minister or other authorised person to determine whether or not to grant you a permission to import goods. The Minister and other authorised persons are authorised to make this decision by the *Customs Act 1901* and the *Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956*.

I declare that the information I have provided in this form is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and I consent to use by DIBP and the Minister of any information that DIBP may already possess which relates to me and to the Australian Federal Police or any other police force providing information they hold about me to DIBP and the Minister for the purpose of determining to grant permission to import goods.

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IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Tests

If you are applying for permission to import goods subject to the police certification test, this form is not required. Simply obtain a B709B Form from your local Police weapons registry and take the original to the relevant DIBP office when the goods are imported into Australia.

If you are applying for permission to import under any other test specified at Schedule 13 (Part 1) of the *Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956* this form is required along with additional information dependant on the test which the importation complies with.

Timeframes

Applications must be lodged prior to importation and goods cannot be imported until permission to import has been approved.

Applications take approximately four weeks for processing once all relevant information is received.

If your application does not include all the required documentation, processing time may be longer.
