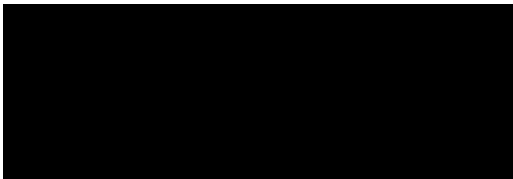

Request for access to documents – Freedom of Information Act 1982 (FOI Act)
