

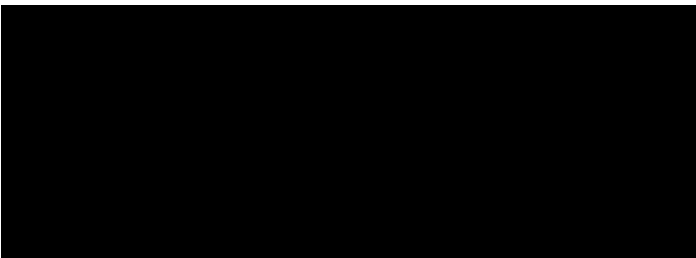

I refer to your email dated 5 November 2015 in which you request access to documents held by the Department of Immigration and Border Protection (the Department) under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (the FOI Act).

**Scope of Request**

You have requested access to the following documents held by the Department:

*'Illustrative Descriptive Material for Tariff Concession Order 0826437.'*

This letter is to notify you of my decision on access to the documents subject to your request.

**Charges**

On 9 November 2015, the Department notified you of the estimated charges associated with processing this request in the amount of \$ [REDACTED].

On 13 November 2015, you paid the charges in full.

**Decision on access**

The Department has identified two documents that fall within the scope of your request. These documents consist of the Illustrative Descriptive Material provided to the Department in relation to Tariff Concession Order 0826437 and were in the possession of Department on 5 November 2015 when your FOI request was received.
